Dear Parents,

Calhoun Falls Charter School is committed to providing a quality education for every child attending our schools. Calhoun Falls Charter aims to ensure that parents have access to all available resources that support and strengthen the academic achievement of their children. According to the federal *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB)*, students must be provided an opportunity to attend another school within the school district if the students are enrolled in a Title I served school identified as in need of improvement. A school is identified as in need of improvement based upon a school not meeting the state's definition of adequately yearly progress (AYP) for two years consecutively.

According to NCLB, schools in need of improvement are required to make choice available for students. Calhoun Falls Charter School has been identified as a school that is required to offer public school choice for this school year with transportation provided by the district. Your child may return to his or her home district if you so choose.

If you are interested in requesting a transfer for your child for the 2011-2012 school year, please call the school no later than September 16, 2011. You may contact administration at 418-8014 regarding Title I Choice procedures.
